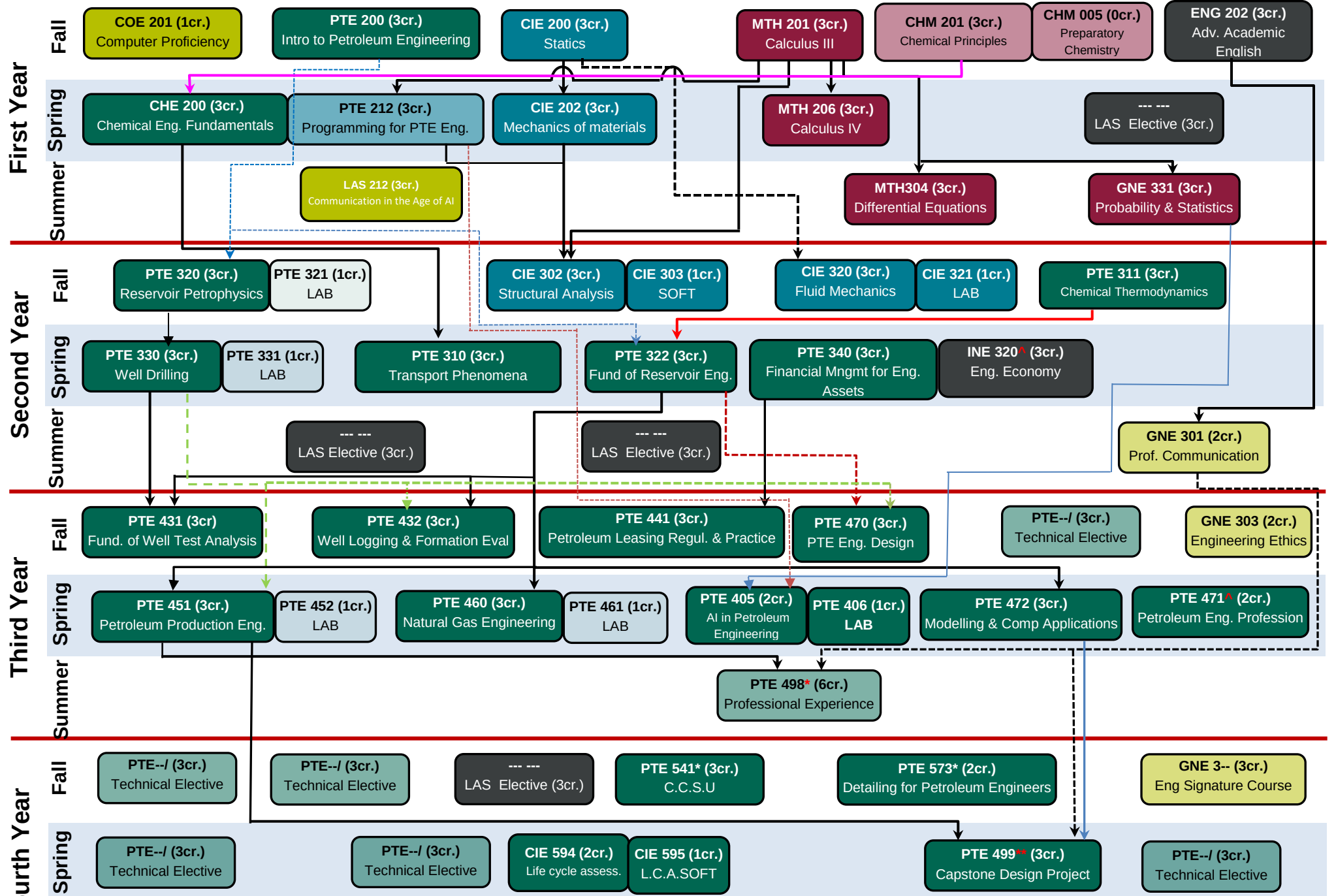


BE Petroleum Engineering Program Flowchart
